We would like to remind residents that dogs are not permitted to run at large. By-law 2006-18 regulates the control of dogs and is strictly enforced. Owners of dogs found running at large are subject to fines.

Burn Permits

Recreational burning is permitted in Essa with a Burn Permit. (Please refer to By-law 2015-92 for guidelines pertaining to lot sizes and clearances for type of burn permit required). Burn permits cost \$40.00 and are valid for the calendar year. Permits are available at the Administration Centre, or online at www.essatownship.on.ca
Only clean dry seasoned wood is
