In person with Debit, Cash or Cheque can be made the Administration Centre. A Drop Box is available at the Administration Centre upper and lower-level doors for payments made during Office Closures.

Pre-Authorized Payments can also be arranged. Payments must be received by the due date to avoid penalties. <u>Increased Online Services</u> - The Township of Essa is excited to advise that it has increased its online services to accept online payments for a variety of services such as parking tickets, dog tags, burn permits, fishing access passes, moving/heavy load permits, road occupancy permits, entrance permits, and a whole lot more.

Additionally, Essa's new Virtual City Hall (VCH) portal is set to go live soon. VCH will provide residents with the ability to access their property tax and/or water accounts at their own convenience, 24-7. The portal will also allow residents to make online payments to their property tax and/or water accounts. Stay tuned to our social media channels for the "go-live" launch of VCH.
