
What's Happening at the Library this Spring?

Budget

The approved 2024 Budget represents a total tax increase of 5.91%, which equals approximately \$43.95 per \$100,000.00 per residential assessment, all while maintaining the lowest tax rate in Simcoe County. For an average residential home assessed at \$395,000.00, the impact of the 2024 Budget equals an approximate increase of \$173.17. Despite a 15% allocation reduction in funding from the province (15% Ontario Municipal Partnership Fund and 15% Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund), the 2024 budget includes increased staffing, new vehicles, road upgrades and resurfacing, new parks, and parks upgrades. Essa will be transferring an amount equal to a 5.7% tax contribution to asset management in keeping with its adopted Asset Management Plan, which, along with the rest of the budget, reinforces Essa's position as the municipality with one of the lowest tax rates north of the GTA.

Do I need a Building Permit?

Yes, but there are some exceptions:

- Building a 15m2 (160sqft) shed with no plumbing and not more than one story; you don't need a permit.
- Adding an air conditioning unit to an existing HVAC system; you don't need a permit.
- Constructing a deck providing it's under 10m2 (108sqft) not attached to a building & not next to egress window or door; you don't need a permit.
